This includes the Silver Daytrippers' club, which is a project we are immensely proud of and is now in its tenth year. However, our funding has been reduced by £20,000 per annum, which is something we were expecting in the current economic climate. We will be asking for your support to help make up the shortfall.

Hughenden—The home of Benjamin Disraeli

We are delighted to announce that we will be visiting Hughenden on Monday 19 June. The stunning red-brick mansion, near High Wycombe, was once the home of Victorian Prime Minister Benjamin Disraeli.

The house has an extensive collection of memorabilia and artefacts to enable you to discover more about this influential statesman. There are stunning views of the formal gardens and surrounding woodland from the third floor of the house. You will have an opportunity to explore the grounds, including the beautiful walled garden at your leisure.

The house was used as a secret base for intelligence staff during the Secord World War and there is an interesting display in the basement with further information.

The café will cater for all our refreshment needs, or you may wish to take a picnic in the grounds as the sun is sure to be shining.

Sissinghurst—A refuge dedicated to beauty

On Thursday 13 July we are making a return visit to Sissinghurst Castle Garden, in Kent (pictured below).

The poet and novelist Vita Sackville-West and her husband Harold Nicolson fell in love with Sissinghurst Castle in the 1930s and created a world renowned garden.

Harold's architectural planning of the garden rooms and the colourful, abundant planting in the gardens by Vita, reflect the romance and intimacy of her writing. It was the backdrop for a diverse history; from the astonishing time as a prison in the 1700s, to being a home to the women's land army. Don't miss the vast panoramic views from the top of the Tower, the working farm and the 450-acre wider estate.

There is a restaurant on site, as well as a plant and souvenir shop for those wishing to buy a memento of their trip.
