A visit to Hatchlands Park

We are looking forward to making our first-ever visit to Hatchlands Park, near Guildford, on Thursday 9 May.

The house was built in 1750 for Admiral Edward Boscawen, a celebrated naval commander who came to prominence during the Seven Years' War.

The house contains splendid interiors by Robert Adam, decorated in an appropriate nautical style reflecting the taste of its first owner. The house also contains the Cobbe collection of historical musical instruments. You will see objects owned by Mozart, Beethoven, Chopin and Elgar. The house is open from 12 noon to 4pm.

There are also 400 acres of parkland to explore, including more formal gardens and an eighteenth century classical stone folly. The landscape features designs by Humphry Repton who was at the height of his career when engaged to improve the park and garden in 1800. Hopefully the bluebells will be in full bloom for our visit.

There is a café offering food and drink where you can recharge your batteries.
